## 1. Opportunities and Updates

- Grossmont-Cuyamaca College Promise replaces Higher Edge Promise with AB 19 requirements:
  - First-time student
  - o Full-time student (at least 12 units each semester)
  - o FAFSA or Dream Act application
  - College onboarding (application, orientation, assessment, and education plan)
  - o Maintain a 2.0 GPA in college
- **AB 19** CA Legislative information (attached) was reviewed and discussed with particular focus on the requirements for participation in the CA College Promise 76369.2:
  - We are currently partnering with GUHSD to establish an Early Commitment to College Program to improve high school student preparation for college
  - We need to inquire with the State regarding our inability to establish a CCAP Partnership Agreement to meet the concurrent enrollment expectations
  - o We are currently participating in the California Community College Guided Pathways
  - o Grant Program through our articulation and alignment alliance efforts
  - We need to maximize student access to need-based financial aid, low FAFSA completion rates due to parents

- **Fundraising** efforts will supplement State funding through the proposed four (4) scholarships with a comprehensive education plan, giving donors different causes to support:
  - Second Year Promise Incentivizes second year and completion \$1,000 per year, 100 students
  - First Year Promise Plus Offers additional support \$500 per year, 25 students
  - Adult Ed Supports transition from adult to college/career \$500 per year, 25 students
  - Special Need Provides a safety net \$500 per year, 25 students
  - \* Fundraising plan totals \$175,000 a year, \$4M endowment would cover costs
  - \* Scholarships available next year and can shift priorities as needed
- CA Promise Grant Spring Pilot Program
  - \* GUHSD-wide campus visits, 9:00-1:00, Cuyamaca May 21st and Grossmont May 24th
    - o Each site provided a bus, possibility of 600 GUHSD juniors on each campus at once
    - Coordinated Outreach leads are working with Mary and Amber on event details, GUHSD sites responsible for student recruitment and supervision
    - o College Liaisons, Zach Gianino and Nancy Lopez, hired through grant
      - College Liaisons support and increase outreach on each high school campus, four hours per week
      - Support Griffin-Coyote Connection efforts, CTE focus, and assist with campus visit logistics
      - Dr. Glover suggested College Liaisons could be introduced at the Principal's Council meeting scheduled on March 21<sup>st</sup>
- 2. 2018 the following items were discussed:
  - **Communication** timely and important, AB 19 begins fall 2018 (June)
    - Communication team will draft one page communication with brief AB 19 information and FAQs for high school students and parents
    - \* Higher Edge Promise website will be renamed and updated
    - \* Sites will determine point of contact/department to contact for "more information" on communication
  - Teams have consistently met this year and updated 2018 goals
    - \* ESL team has not been able to meet
    - \* Counseling team will begin meeting this semester to begin information sharing and determine goals, GCCCD will re-evaluate members and Mary will determine GUHSD participation
  - CCAP Partnership Agreement is still in negotiation
    - Chancellor will review AB 19 with the State Chancellor's office
