New Items

A. Multiple Measures Update From Colleges

- a. Poster is outdated and needs to be replaced. The new poster ultimately works in the students favor.
- b. When Grossmont visits the high school the students will receive the Accuplacer exam. When Cuyamaca visits, students will not need to take the Accuplacer exam. If students register directly through either college, they must take the Accuplacer exam.

B. Goals for ECEA

- a. More High School Teachers visit college teachers classrooms to see what college math classes look like.
- b. College classes offered at the High School for graduated seniors to get ahead in math.
- c. Work on a visiting schedule for both GUHSD and GCCCD to facilitate classroom observations.
- d. Make a ECEA Math website and link it to the District Math Website (that is going to exist in the future).

C. Pre-Calculus Summer Offerings at Grossmont and Cuyamaca Colleges:

- a. Department Chairs provide a list of interested students
 - i. This list needs to be submitted to Tiffany Jokerst by Friday April 13th.
- b. Ensure students are registered
 - i. Students must be registered with GCCCD by April 13th and the

GCCCD Student ID must be entered in the spreadsheet provided to Tiffany Jokerst by April 13th.

- c. Cost
 - i. The student fees are approximately \$21-30. The book ranges from \$100-150, but GCCCD is looking into getting the cost covered. To be safe, we are telling students that the course will cost no more than \$200.
 - ii. Tuition fees are waived for high school students.
- d. Start and End Dates
 - i. June 11th - July 19th.
- e. How many units
 - i. This is a 6 unit college class.
- f. Location? Maybe a GUHSD Campus?
 - i. El Cajon Valley High School has expressed an interest in hosting a class on their campus which would be offered Monday - Friday 7:30 am start time. Monte Vista High School has also expressed an interest in offering a section on their campus and tentatively plan to host the class in the afternoon with a 12:30 start time. Depending on the number of interested students on other sites, we are looking for another location to offer a third course on the high school campus.
 - ii. There is a plan in place to ask ECEA for funds for transportation for students that need to be bussed to the campus that is offering the course nearest them. The students would be picked up from their current high school campus if the funds are approved.
- g. CR/NCR
 - i. Can student receive CR/NCR from college and High School so that it does not affect their GPA since it is a 4 point A?
 - 1. After speaking with the head counselor at WHHS, it sounds like CR/NCR is not an option for our students.
 - ii. Can the summer pre-calculus course be used to replace a low pre-calculus grade?
 - 1. After speaking with the head counselor at WHHS, it was conveyed that the summer pre-calculus course can not replace the high school level grade. Since they are different course numbers BOTH grades would appear on the transcript.
