- Dual Enrollment - CCAP and CTE - Mary gave update from Dual Enrollment Committee. Looking at CTE programs as a way to start Dual Enrollment. CCAP dual enrollment must be offered during bell schedule. Non CCAP may be offered outside of school day. CCAP allows you to close enrollment to HS students only. Non CCAP can be opened to all students, outside of school day. MOU in process. Goal to have MOU in place with pilot during Spring 2018. CTE Deans will be invited to Dual Enrollment Committee.
 - Focus on CTE as stepping stone?
 - Need to work on details for CTE class, curriculum, teachers, lab kits, fees, books, etc.
 - We need to look at current articulation agreements to avoid duplication.
 - Mary has requested a full list of all CTE courses at GCCCD to identify articulated courses, will then share with Principals.
 - Javier suggested that pairing HS/CC teachers to match programs as a starting point based on strengths of both schools. Also, consider POS at each college site to be Perkins supported.
 - Need to consider benefits/challenges of Articulation vs. Dual Enrollment (higher stakes)
- Apprenticeship debrief - Good Apprenticeship turn-out. Mid May not a good time for HS students (170 HS), 40 Adults, plus outside Adults, and Special Ed transition.
 - Include campus tours next time
 - Combine w Grossmont College's Career Expo October 11?
 - Revisit for next meeting
- Articulation & CATEMA updates - Leslie getting many calls and emails with questions from teachers. The CATEMA training in February was too far removed. Leslie is not seeing too much in CATEMA at this point. Good idea to have paper back up for transition year.
- CCPT proposals - both G & C applied. Will support our current work around alignment and articulation G - ICT, G - Energy, Manufacturing, ICT.
